OMAHA (9/21/18) – On Sunday, October 14, 2018, at 2 pm, Film Streams and **The Willa Cather Foundation** will present a one-of-a-kind celebration of one of the most important American novelists of the first half of the twentieth century at the Dundee Theater (4952 Dodge St.).

To celebrate the 100th anniversary of Cather's landmark work "My Ántonia," screenwriter and producer Victoria Riskin and Cather scholar Dr. Charles Johanningsmeier will join Willa Cather Foundation Executive Director Ashley Olson for a discussion on adapting the novel for a 1995 TV movie.
